WEEK FIVE: FOCUS ON EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS AND THE FAMILY

16th - 22nd September 2024

1 Timothy 2:1-7

First of all, then, I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way. This is good, and it is pleasing in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all people to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus, who gave himself as a ransom for all, which is the testimony given at the proper time. For this I was appointed a preacher and an apostle (I am telling the truth, I am not lying), a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and truth.

Education began in a perfect environment, the Garden of Eden. It was a family environment. The Teacher was perfect, so were the students and the classroom. The students had been given the charge to multiply, fill the earth and subdue it. Together with that they were given all authority over creation. Adam the first student was to educate his wife, Eve, about the garden and all it contained. Together they would educate their children about the management of creation, and God's plan to fill the whole earth with sons and daughters who loved and honored Him. As a result, in the unfolding generations, through education, the whole earth would be subdued and filled with the glory of God as the waters cover the sea.

However, judging from the conversation Eve had with the serpent, it is apparent that Adam did not do his teaching assignment well. Soon both students broke the rules, and the Teacher threw them out of the classroom. From then on, the classroom became imperfect, and all students were prone to breaking the rules. The need for education did not end with the fall of man but the potential for wrong education and dysfunctional institutions multiplied as the devil became the god of the world system. The Teacher however remained perfect and provided a way for his students to be restored.

When the Teacher completed his work of redemption, He repeated the original charge to "go into the whole world" and teach the nations His ways. This time the charge was given to another set of students: His disciples. It was like the "pause" button that had been pressed at the fall of man was now released to complete the original mission of filling the earth and subduing it. At the heart of the Great Commission is the command to teach *the nations to observe all that He commanded*. This forms the bedrock for any education system aligned to the Kingdom of God. Its philosophy must be based on the teachings of Jesus.

Education (human capacity development) is vital for economic and social development. Education is a channel through which the wisdom, knowledge, understanding, skills and confidence necessary for life in the modern world are acquired. Through education life is communicated from one generation to the next generation. This life expressed in values, beliefs, truth and culture is seen in our families, in our morals, in our social behavior, on our roads, marketplaces, places of entertainment, and in the professions: law, industry, medicine, agriculture, commerce, the military etc. The quality of our culture is reflected in the quality of our education system.

Education affects every area of human experience. Education standards in any country play a key role in determining the level of social and economic development. The way we see our world, the values we hold important, the skills we consider to be necessary, our perceptions of the past, present, and future are all affected by the education we received and our educational philosophies. Education is thus a process that forms individuals and indeed whole generations for

life. The education systems of countries are templates that determine what the next generation will look like.

Educational institutions, particularly those affiliated with or founded by the Church, play a crucial role in shaping the spiritual, intellectual, and social lives of individuals, families, and communities. These institutions, ranging from primary schools to universities and theological institutions contribute to the Church's mission of education, evangelization, and societal transformation. Some of the key roles they fulfill are:

1. Discipleship

Teaching Doctrine and Theology

Church-affiliated educational institutions are supposed to provide structured instruction in Christian doctrines and Biblical studies. This ensures that followers of Christ understand the faith and come to a knowledge of all truth.

Spiritual Formation

Beyond intellectual development, these institutions have a mandate to nurture spiritual growth. They offer opportunities for prayer, worship, and community service, helping students develop a personal relationship with God and a strong Christian identity.

3. Social Engagement and Community Building

Promoting Social Justice

Christian educational institutions have the opportunity to focus on issues of social justice, advocating for the poor, marginalized, and oppressed. Through education and service projects, they inspire students to work toward creating a more just and equitable society.

Community Building

Church-affiliated schools foster a sense of Christian community among students, staff, and families. This sense of belonging and shared purpose strengthens the wider Church community and reinforces Christian values in everyday life.

4. Intellectual and Academic Development

Providing Quality Education

Many church-affiliated institutions in Uganda are known for their academic rigor and excellence. They combine faith and reason, encouraging critical thinking while also grounding learning in a Christian worldview. This holistic approach prepares students to engage with the world intellectually and morally.

Engaging in Theological Scholarship

Higher education institutions, particularly theological institutions and universities, contribute to theological scholarship by researching and developing new insights into faith, ethics, and religious practice. This scholarship enriches the Church's teachings and helps it to guide policy formation respond to contemporary challenges and.

5. Preparation for Ministry and Leadership in the Kingdom of God

Raising the next Generation of Leaders

Theological institutions are called to provide the necessary training for individuals pursuing ordained ministry and leadership roles in the Kingdom of God. This includes instruction in pastoral care, church administration, and marketplace ministry.

Supporting Professions

Educational institutions play a vital role in nurturing professionals. Through discernment programs and mentorship, they help individuals recognize and respond to their calling to serve God in the world.

Conclusion

Educational institutions founded by members of the Body of Christ have a mandate to serve as vital agents of discipleship, moral development, intellectual growth, and social engagement. By combining academic excellence with spiritual and ethical formation, these institutions not only prepare individuals for meaningful lives but also contribute to the broader mission of the Church in transforming society. Through nurturing future leaders, and responsible citizens, these institutions play a central role in the family and its outreach to the world.

This is a week to pray for educational institutions and their ministry to the family, the wider Body of Christ, and the world. Pray for the educational institutions that train your family members, those operated by the Church you are part of, and even for those that claim to be "secular". Pray that these educational institutions, especially those founded by members of the Body of Christ, will rise to their calling in society.

PROCLAMATION FOR THE EDUCATION SECTOR

God is raising parents, educators and leaders at all levels of authority in the education sector that will lead their learners in righteousness and justice.

They shall shelter their learners from the storms blowing in society and especially in the education sphere. Like the shadow of a great rock in a weary land, they will protect their learners and not take advantage of them. They will refresh their learners like a drink of water refreshes a weary desert traveler. They will speak truth and through their words the ears of their learners will be opened and eyes of their learners will be enlightened for understanding and to see new horizons and possibilities.

Unrighteous and dishonest leaders are being removed from places of authority in the education sphere. These include:

- o The troublemakers, thieves, poor decision-makers, the greedy and selfish
- Those that have entered the sphere of education with evil plans and schemes
- Those who lie and pervert truth and justice
- Those who practice ungodliness, thus depriving their learners and those who are hungry for knowledge through corruption and other means
- Those who sexually exploit their learners with wicked schemes like "sex for marks"

- Those who destabilize the education system by instigating and constantly promoting strikes in educational institutions
- Those who receive salaries but do not teach their learners

A season is now emerging where the leadership at all educational levels is truly honorable, noble, selfless and generous.

Parents will take the primary responsibility for the education of their children.

The education system will be built on the foundations of the values espoused by the Word of God.

Learners will no longer be subjected to humanistic indoctrination in our educational institutions.

Uganda's children will be taught of the Lord and learn His ways and great will be their peace. The archaic education system left by the colonial powers will finally be overthrown and a new values and outcomes based system that promotes critical thinking, creativity and innovation, excellence will take centre stage. Graduates from the education system will be disciplined, knowledgeable, skilled, future ready and relevant to the times they will graduate in. They will be agents of progressive transformation for their times and thus enable the country reach its greatest potential and destiny.
